## **ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY**

### **SUMMARY:**

The Environmental, Health and Safety (EHS) policy is committed to establish and promote safe and healthy environment for faculty, staff, students, visitors, and surrounding community members of Institute of Industrial Electronics Engineering (IIEE), PCSIR and to preserve resources and protect the environment from adverse impacts.

### **STATEMENT:**

The Institute aims to provide health and safety at the campus by preventive and protective measures establish through policies and standard operating procedures (SOPs) in conformance with applicable laws and regulations of Occupational Health and Safety Act of Provincial and Federal Government. In addition, relevant published EHS standards and best practices for the protection of health, safety and the environment shall be used as guidance when no applicable regulation exists.
