



## **NOTIFICATION**

In pursuance to powers delegated to the Academic Council by Syndicate vide its Resolution No. SYN-186.4(b) dated 26-10-2018, it is hereby notified that the Academic Council vide its Resolution No. AC-171.3(ii) dated 05-03-2026 has approved following Admission Policy 2026 and Criteria for admission in First Year Undergraduate Programmes at the affiliated institute i.e., Institute of Industrial Electronics Engineering (IIEE), under section 18(2)(c) of the University Act:

### **Eligibility Criteria for Admissions-2026:**

- a. Applicant must be a Pakistani National.
- b. Candidates who had passed HSC-I (Pre-Engineering/Computer Science) Examinations in the Year 2025 with at least 60% marks or those who had passed HSC (Pre-Engineering/Computer Science) or Equivalent Examinations in 2025, 2024, or 2023 with at least 60% Marks are eligible to apply.
- c. Candidates appearing in A-Level or 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Examinations will be allowed to appear in Entry Test. They will be offered provisional admission based on the Marks secured in the O-Level and Entry Test.
- d. HSC-II or Equivalent Foreign Examination candidates will be required to submit their final Grade Sheet /IBCC Equivalency Certificate with minimum of 60% Marks latest by 30th October, 2026.
- e. Candidates who have passed Diploma of Associate Engineer (DAE) Certificate in the same/relevant field from the Provincial Board of Technical Education in the current year or year 2025, 2024, or 2023 (with at least 60% Marks) are also eligible to apply.
- f. An applicant should have passed the Pre-admission Entry Test of
  - IIEE administered by NED UET at NED Karachi (main campus) or at PCSIR Laboratories Complex, Lahore with a minimum of 50% marks. Or;
  - NED University of Engineering & Technology with at least 50% marks.

### **Merit Criteria for Admissions-2026:**

Provisional admissions would be offered on the basis of merit score. The criteria for determining the merit score of candidates is outlined as:

Merit Score = 40% (HSC Part-I/O-Level marks or equivalent) + 60% weightage to the Entry Test. Admission will be confirmed only after the candidate submits the final HSC / equivalent result showing at least 60% marks.

#### **a. Marks Deduction for Additional Attempt / Improvement:**

For applicants who have passed their qualifying examination in 2023, 2024, or 2025 their merit positions for the purpose of admission shall be determined after deduction of 0.91% marks from the total obtained in their respective qualifying examinations. The same deduction shall apply in case of improvement (Including applicants who have taken improvement examination in the same calendar year as that of the HSC / Qualifying Examinations).

**b. Appearance in More than One Entry Test**

If an applicant clears more than one entry test (IIEE, NED) entry tests, the best score will be considered for merit.

**c. Additional Marks for Hafiz-e-Quran 1.82%:**

Any applicant who is Hafiz-e-Quran and has passed IIEE/NED entry test shall have 1.82% of marks added to the HSC / equivalent marks obtained by the candidate. As per the previous policy.

- He/She shall have to provide the original Sanad of Hafiz-e-Quran from Wafaq-ul-Madaris or any other board /madrassah as recognized by the government.
- The applicant shall have to appear and qualify the Hafiz-e-Quran test as notified by IIEE.

**d. Tie in Merit Position:**

The tie in merit position shall be resolved as per the approved policy approved which is reproduced as under:

- Aggregate marks obtained in Pre-Admission Entry Test shall be the criterion for resolving the merit.
- Any further tie shall be resolved by considering the marks obtained in sections of Mathematics, then Physics, and then Chemistry/Computer Science of HSC or equivalent.

**Note:**

- Admission will be confirmed only after submission of the final HSC / equivalent result with minimum 60% marks.
- Applicants with Computer Science Group will be required to study and qualify Chemistry as non-credit course offered by the HEI during First Year Fall Semester. Institute will charge an additional fee for this NC course.
